Early College is a program that will allow a limited number of students in the Class of 2017 (with a GPA of 2.7 or higher, and qualifying test scores) the chance to complete a 2-year Associate's Degree throughout the standard 4 years of high school plus one additional year...with most costs covered by the school district.
