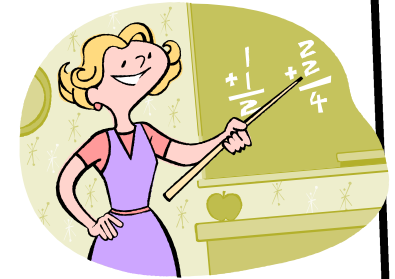

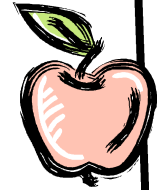

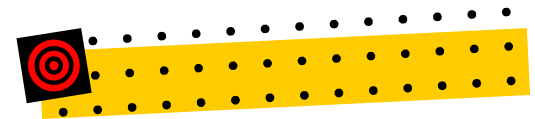
Throughout the day, I teach my own classes or I go into the general education classes and support students.
