

## Saxon Math – Seventh Grade

Throughout the course of the year we will investigate the following math concepts in a variety of ways. Due to the spiraling affect in which the Saxon Math program is based upon, these concepts will continually be reviewed, revisited, and built upon.

### Tests/Quizzes

Students are tested after every five lessons. Students are given a study sheet that covers all the math concepts that will be on the test. All tests consist of 20 problems.
